

Sounds-Write sequence —Polysyllabic Words

SKILLS:

- segment: to spell polysyllabic words by segmenting them first into syllables, and then each syllable, in turn, into sounds;
- blend: to read words by first blending sounds into syllables, and then syllables, in turn, into words.

KNOWLEDGE:

- some words are made up of more than one syllable;
- the spelling of some common syllables, such as prefixes and suffixes;
- some polysyllabic words contain schwas.

SEQUENCE:

In the Polysyllabic Words Lessons we start by working at sound-level, then move to syllable-level work, and we also analyze spelling difficulties in Polysyllabic Words, including schwas. Polysyllabic words are presented in a logical sequence, from simple to complex.
